Genesis 2:1-3

Discovery Treasures:

So God's original work of creation was completed. The heavens and the earth in all their vast array.

VAST ARRAY: *Vast* means huge, widespread, boundless, immeasurable, massive, colossal, and epic. *Array* means an impressive display or range of a particular type of thing, an ordered series or arrangement. So when you put these two words together, a **vast array** means an epic impressive display!

God finished the work of creation in six days, then rested on the seventh, But He has never stopped being involved with His creation. He is alive today. How cool is it to know that God is involved with us every day? God is also still just as powerful and magnificent as He has always been. God has never, and will never change. It tells us in James 1:7 "Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows."

And did you know that God loves you more than you can even imagine? He does! God is our true Father, our true Father who created us, and loves us beyond our comprehension. And think about this...God is your father's true father, and your mother's true father too, He is your best friend's true father, and your enemy's true father. That is why He instructed us to love our enemies—because He does. There's a quote floating around among Christians that I really like. It says, "God is good all the time, and all the time God is good." There's so

much truth to that quote.
