Genesis 1:26-28

Then God said, “Let us make mankind in our image, in our likeness, so that they may rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky, over the livestock and all the wild animals, and over all the creatures that move along the ground.” So God created mankind in his own image, in the image of God he created them; male and female he created them. God blessed them and said to them, “Be fruitful and increase in number; fill the earth and subdue it. Rule over the fish in the sea and the birds in the sky and over every living creature that moves on the ground.”

Discovery Treasures:

Isn't this the most amazing creation yet? Mankind, man and woman, you and me, we were created by God. We did not evolve from apes, we were created. And the apes were created by God. We were created by the all powerful God, the God that created the heavens and the earth, the one and only God that created the universe. But there is one very special thing about us as humans; we were created in **His** (God's) image! Not other creature was created in His image, only mankind. We know we were created by God because of what God said in Jeremiah 1:5; “Before I (God) formed you in the womb I knew you, before you were born I set you apart;” How cool is that? He not only made us in His image, but He also knew us before we were even born! You are very special to God, there is no doubt.

Now let's take a look at exactly **how** God created man and woman. Genesis 2:7 tells us how He created man; “Then the Lord God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life, and the man became a living being.” Genesis 2:21 tells us how God created woman. “So the Lord God caused the man to fall into a deep sleep; and while he was sleeping, He (God) took one of the man's ribs and then closed up the place with flesh. Then the Lord God made a woman from the rib He had taken out of the man...” Pretty cool, huh?

NOSTRILS: Nostrils are your nose holes. They allow air to enter your lungs.

God also gave us five amazing qualities that we use everyday. These five qualities are known as the five senses. The five senses are sight, smell, hearing, taste, and touch. And what's really cool is that you can experience these five senses physically and spiritually. You can see nature with your physical eyes, yet you can see God in nature with your spiritual eyes. You can smell the flowers with your physical nose, yet you can smell the sweetness of God in those same flowers with your spiritual nose. You can hear the birds singing with your physical ears, yet you can hear God's praises the birds are singing with your spiritual ears. You can taste that yummy grilled cheese and tomato soup with your physical tongue, yet you can taste and see that the Lord is good (Psalm 34:8 Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in him.) with your spiritual "taster." When you touch, you feel. So you can feel the feathers of a bird, yet you can feel safe in God's feathers (Psalm 91:4 He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.").

Because God made you in His image, you can be certain...You matter to God!
